PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES CAREFULLY

Dilutes Australia Awards Show Season begins 1st August every year & finishes on 31st July of the following year.

ALL results sheets MUST be received by the Scorer by the 31st August following closing date for placings to be eligible

Official Points Recording books are available from the National General Secretary

The official Dilutes Australia nomination form MUST be used. The Scorer has advised that no nominations will be accepted in any other format. The form is available from the General Secretary & the Company website

Copies of Dilutes Australia current membership card & registration MUST accompany ANY nomination. The Scorer will not accept any nomination unless these copies are included.

NO nomination forms &/or fees will be accepted by the Scorer. The Scorer will return any such nominations to the sender. These MUST be sent to the Branch Secretary for receipting of fees & forwarding of nomination to Scorer.

The Scorer DOES NOT:-

- 1. Verify Results - get them signed or downloaded**
- 2. Complete details at the top of the results' sheets**
- 3. Write placings or classes on results' sheets**

Any of the above will result in the sheets being returned to you for completion OR the placings simply not being counted as eligible for points

ALL NOMINATION FEES ARE PER HORSE PER COLOUR

HORSE OF THE YEAR – (HOTY)

Rules

1. Nomination is payable before OR on the date of the third nominated HOTY show in each Promotion Group Area from which points are to be gained.
2. Nominations received after the date of the third nominated show for each Promotion Group Area will gain points from the date of nomination PLUS the Qld Dilute Championships, Colourama Spectacular & All Breeds Extravaganza & SQ Youngstock Show if attended.
3. Points are taken from 11 (ELEVEN) shows - subject to Rules 3/4, made up of the following:
 - Qld Dilute Championships
 - Colourama Spectacular
 - SQ Youngstock Show EXCEPT FOR Best Presented
 - the 8 HOTY shows from any one Promotion Group Area at any one time.
4. The highest PG total will be used if competing in more than one PG Area. The list of PG HOTY shows for each year will be circulated by the Qld Branch before the show year starts.
5. Horses may compete in any or all Promotion Group Areas. It is not compulsory to be nominated in the Promotion Group Awards in order to compete for the QLD HOTY. There is no minimum number of shows to be attended.
6. Points will be: 1st - 4, 2nd - 2, 3rd - 1. No Champion points allocated.
7. For tied placings, the following points apply: 1st - 3 each, 2nd - 1 1/2 each, 3rd - 1/2 each.
8. HOTY shows judged by an **accredited** Dilutes Australia Ltd judge will gain **full points**. HOTY shows judged by an **unaccredited** Dilutes Australia judge will gain **half the points** allocated for that placing
9. Points are calculated on results sheets received from exhibitors **by 31st August. Result sheets MUST be FULLY completed for results to be eligible. This includes the FULL name of the judge. ONLY the official DA points recording book is acceptable for the recording of class placings.**
10. Where a washout show is 'washed out' (cancelled by the show society), the next following nominated wash out show will replace it for points. Same if that show is washed out etc.
11. In the event of a colt being gelded during the show season, the category in which they attended the most shows and gained the most points will be the category for which their final points will be calculated. i.e. if they attended 4 shows for 10 points as a colt and 5 shows for 16 points as a gelding, they will receive 26 points as a gelding.
12. In the event of a total score tie for Champion, 2 Champion Trophies will be awarded but no Reserve Champion. In the event of a tie for Reserve Champion, 2 Reserve Champion trophies will be given.

DIAMOND AWARD **OPEN TO ALL SOLID DILUTES**

NOMINATION FEE \$50 - paid once only

1. This award can be won only once under one owner. Horses that have gained the Diamond Award under one owner can be re-nominated by new owners. (Ownership must be official through transfer, and new owner's membership paid).
 2. All progressive awards (bronze, silver, gold etc) gained by a horse go to the owner with whom the points were accumulated, even if the horse is sold whilst still competing for the Award.
 3. Points will only be back dated to the 1st of August in the current show season in which a horse is nominated.
 4. Fees for back dating are \$5 per month, per horse, from date of nomination, plus cost of results books needed to record previous points. This is in addition to the initial nomination fee.
 5. All Foal Recorded & Permanently Registered horses under 2 years may accumulate points BUT these points will not actually be awarded until the Permanently Registered horse has reached 1st August of the year the horse turns 2 OR for Foal Recorded horses, has passed classification/been upgraded and is adult registered with Dilutes Australia Ltd.
 6. Solid Dilute classes at Royal Shows, Horse Expos, National Shows, Championships, Agricultural Societies which hold a 'feature' show (in writing) and annual shows run by Dilutes Australia gain double points. Each Promotion Group is only permitted one (1) double points show per show year. Except for the GMPG where one (1) Feature Show for the North of Brisbane and one (1) for the south. Points from only one (1) GMPG Feature Show will be counted per horse.
 7. Solid Dilutes who are part of Promotion Teams may claim 3 points for each parade participated in. LIMIT of SIX (6) parades over the 3 years may be so used.
 8. Points may be gained OVER ANY 3 CONSECUTIVE YEARS. Ie: once a signed results sheet has been submitted, they must continue to be submitted until the horse has accumulated the required number of points for an award. If the award is not gained in the first 3 consecutive years, it may be gained over the 2nd, 3rd & 4th years or the 3rd, 4th & 5th years etc. The previous year's points drop off – e.g. if going into the 2nd, 3rd & 4th years then the 1st year's points are lost, so the horse must make up the lost year's points as well as the balance of points to reach 300.
 9. Points may be gained in led, ridden, jumping, novelties and harness classes but NO POINTS will be permitted where the ribbon goes to the handler, rider or driver (ie Handler, rider or driver classes).
-

10. Full points will be gained from solid dilute classes at any show which is judged by a Dilutes Australia accredited judge. Points will be halved for solid dilute classes where an unaccredited Dilutes Australia judge officiates
11. TWO THIRDS of the points MUST BE OBTAINED IN SOLID DILUTE CLASSES before a horse is eligible for the Award. The remaining points may be gained in Open classes (Open Registered breed or performance class OTHER THAN Dilutes Australia).
12. Results sheets must be signed by the judge or an official of the show or they will not be counted.
13. BRONZE AWARD - 50 points, SILVER - 100 points, GOLD - 150 points, DIAMOND - 300 points

PRISM AWARD OPEN TO ALL ANCILLARIES

NOMINATION FEE \$50 - paid once only

1. This award can be won only once under one owner. Horses that have gained the Prism Award under one owner can be re-nominated by new owners. (Ownership must be official through transfer, and new owner's membership paid).
2. All progressive awards (bronze, silver, gold etc) gained by a horse, go to the owner with whom the points were accumulated, even if the horse is sold while still competing for the award.
3. Points will only be backdated to the 1st August in the current show season in which a horse is nominated.
4. Fees for backdating are \$5 per month, per horse from date of nomination, plus cost of results books needed to record backdated points. This is in addition to the initial nomination fee.
5. All Foal Recorded & Permanently Registered horses under 2 years may accumulate points BUT these points will not actually be awarded until the Permanently Registered horse has reached 1st August of the year the horse turns 2 OR for Foal Recorded horses, has passed classification/been upgraded and is adult registered with Dilutes Australia Ltd.
6. Ancillary classes at Royal Shows, Horse Expos, National Shows, Championships, Agricultural Shows which hold a Feature Show (in writing) & Dilutes Australia run Annual Shows gain double points. Darling Downs Promotion Group is only permitted one (1) double points show per show year while the Greater Moreton has the choice of one (1) of two (2).
7. Points may be gained OVER ANY 3 CONSECUTIVE YEARS. ie: once a results sheet has been submitted, they must continue to be submitted until the horse has accumulated the required number of points for an award. If the award is not gained in the first 3 consecutive years, it may be gained over the 2nd, 3rd & 4th years or the 3rd, 4th & 5th years etc. The

previous year's points drop off – e.g. if going into the 2nd, 3rd & 4th years then the 1st year's points are lost, so the horse must make up the lost year's points as well as the balance of points to reach 300.

8. Points may be gained in led, ridden, jumping, novelties and harness classes but NO POINTS will be permitted where the ribbon goes to the handler, rider or driver (ie Handler, rider or driver classes).
9. Full points will be gained from Ancillary classes at any show which is judged by a Dilutes Australia accredited judge. Points will be halved for Ancillary classes where an unaccredited Dilutes Australia judge officiates **EXCEPT** for Dilutes Australia members residing outside Promotion Group areas and showing OUTSIDE these areas. These members are permitted to use points gained in ancillary classes under judges other than Dilutes Australia Ltd provided results sheets are signed by the judges concerned.
10. TWO THIRDS of the points MUST BE OBTAINED IN ANCILLARY* CLASSES before a horse is eligible for the award. The remaining points may be gained in Open classes (Open Registered Breed or Performance classes OTHER THAN Dilutes Australia). * Where no Ancillary Classes are available "Any other breed" classes may be used. Enclose programme as proof.
11. Results sheets must be signed by the Judge or an Official of the Show, or they will not be counted.
12. BRONZE-50 points; SILVER- 100 points; GOLD-150 points; PRISM-300 pts.

1. This award can be won only once under one owner. Horses that have gained the Harlequin Award under one owner can be re-nominated by new owners. (Ownership must be official through transfer, and new owner's membership paid).
2. All progressive awards (bronze, silver, gold etc) gained by a horse go to the owner with whom the points were accumulated, even if the horse is sold while competing for the Award.
3. Points may be backdated to the date of Foal Recording / Registration if proof of placing can be obtained. Proof is described as a copy of other breed award results book with signatures or signed letter from judge / show society or event / breed society stating all relevant details for placing.
4. All Foal Recorded & Permanently Registered horses under 2 years may accumulate points BUT these points will not actually be awarded until the Permanently Registered horse has reached 1st August of the year the horse turns 2 OR for Foal Recorded horses, has passed classification/been upgraded and is adult registered with Dilutes Australia Ltd.
5. Double Points will be awarded for placings gained at a Royal Show, Horse Expo, National Show, Championships, Agricultural Society which holds a "Feature" Show (in writing) and Annual Shows run by Dilutes Australia.
6. Points may be gained OVER ANY 3 CONSECUTIVE YEARS. ie: once a signed results sheet has been submitted, they must continue to be submitted until the horse has accumulated the required number of points for an award. If the award is not gained in the first 3 consecutive years, it may be gained over the 2nd, 3rd & 4th years or the 3rd, 4th & 5th years etc.
7. Points may be gained in led, ridden, jumping, novelties, and harness classes, BUT NO POINTS will be permitted where the ribbon goes to the handler, rider, or driver. (ie: handler classes, etc)
8. At Shows attended that are outside a Promotion Group area, Bonus points (2) will be awarded in classes which are specifically for a colour – i.e. palomino stallion 4 years &

over or buckskin/dun stallion 4 years & over. No bonus points will be awarded for Champion, Grand Champion, Supreme or Hi Point.

9. If a horse is nominated for both Solid Dilute & Ancillary Awards, all placings/ribbons won provide points for both Awards UNLESS Ancillary Classes are provided at the show, in which case, ribbons/places won in the Solid Dilute Classes at that show give points to the Solid Dilute Awards only. If the show has no Ancillary Classes, then points gained in the Solid Dilute Classes may be used for both the Solid Dilute & Ancillary Awards.
10. Results Sheets must be handed in each year by the **31st AUGUST** . Failure to submit results sheets will invalidate points for that period.
11. Results sheets must be signed by the judge, steward, or official of the event, or they will not be counted.

2. All progressive awards (bronze, silver, gold etc) gained by a horse go to the owner with whom the points were accumulated, even if the horse is sold while competing for the Award.
3. **Points will only be backdated to the 1st of August in the current show season in which the horse is nominated if proof of placing can be obtained.** Proof is described as a copy of other breed award results book with signatures or signed letter from judge / show society or event / breed society stating all relevant details for placing.
4. Fees for back dating are \$5 per month, per horse, from date of nomination, plus cost of results books needed to record previous points. This is in addition to the initial nomination fee.
5. Double Points will be awarded for BCD only placings gained at a Royal Show, Horse Expo, National Show, Championships, Agricultural Society which holds a "Feature" Show (in writing) and Annual Shows run by Dilutes Australia.
6. Points may be gained OVER ANY 3 CONSECUTIVE YEARS. ie: once a signed results sheet has been submitted, they must continue to be submitted until the horse has accumulated the required number of points for an award. If the award is not gained in the first 3 consecutive years, it may be gained over the 2nd, 3rd & 4th years or the 3rd, 4th & 5th years etc.
7. Points may be gained in led, ridden, jumping, novelties, and harness classes, BUT NO POINTS will be permitted where the ribbon goes to the handler, rider, or driver. (ie: handler classes, etc)
8. **Members & horses resident OUTSIDE of Promotion Group areas where there are no BCD Classes available at the show, may use their Colour Class placings. E.g. Paint, Pinto etc. Breed Classes such as AQHA or Arabian derivative not acceptable. SHOW PROGRAMME MUST BE ATTACHED IN SUPPORT OF PLACINGS. TORN OUT PAGE NOT ACCEPTABLE. MUST BE WHOLE SHOW PROGRAMME.**
9. Official Points Recording Books are available from the National General Secretary.
10. Results Sheets must be handed in each year by the **31st AUGUST** . Failure to submit results sheets will invalidate points for that period.
11. Results sheets must be signed by the judge, steward, or official of the event, or they will not be counted.
12. BRONZE AWARD - 50 points, SILVER - 100 points, GOLD - 150 points, HARLEQUIN - 300 points

2nd = 3 points
3rd = 2 points
4th = 1 point

Reserve Champion = 1 point
Champion = 2 points
Grand Champion = 3 points
Supreme = 6 points
